


Pro Shop Corner

Tip Of The Quarter

As many of you may know, the rough around Oakhurst is getting healthier, making your approach shots more difficult. Instead of trying a "miracle shot," you should take your medicine and play for the safe part of the fairway or green. The key to advancing the ball from thick, rough is playing a high percentage shot. If the ball is deep in the rough with grass behind the ball, do not attempt to hit a fairway wood, medium or long iron. Instead, use a short iron (7 or less) to put the ball back in play... Here are a few tips to keep in mind when hitting your next shot from the rough!

- Grip the club firmer with the left hand to prevent it from twisting at impact.
- Aim further to the right -- the clubhead will tend to shut closed as it moves through the grass.
- Ball position play the ball slightly back of center.
- Hover the clubhead on top of the grass so it does not get stuck when you start your backswing.

These few tips will help you escape from the rough, but you still must make a smart decision. Don't try to attempt a shot that even the world's best players have difficulty pulling off.







COCKTAIL RECIPE OF THE QUARTER

WARM APPLE CIDER COCKTAIL

Bring in the new year with a cocktail recipe from our food and beverage staff! Enjoy with or without alcohol!

INGREDIENTS

- 4 cups apple cider
- ¼ cup <u>brown sugar</u>
- 1 cinnamon stick
- 1 star anise (optional)
- ½ teaspoon whole cloves
- ¼ teaspoon <u>allspice</u>
- 6 oz <u>vodka</u>





- In a medium saucepan, combine the apple cider, sugar, cinnamon, star anise, cloves, and allspice.
- Bring the mixture up to a boil over high heat. Once the mixture comes to a boil, turn the heat down to low and allow it to simmer for 10 minutes.
- Use a mesh strainer to remove the spices from the cider.
- Pour the vodka into the cider and serve warm.


